### POWER OF ATTORNEY

Be it known that I/we the undersigned

residing in

hereby grant to:

sufficient powers before the competent agencies and authorities of

so that either of them, acting jointly, severally or indistinctly, may apply for and take all necessary steps to obtain patents of invention, and register trade names and trademarks, industrial models and designs, copyrights, domain names and exercising due protection of the rights thereon corresponding thereto, for which purpose the said attorneys-in-fact are hereby empowered to carry out before the competent administrative and judicial authorities any proceedings as may be required to achieve the above mentioned purpose, to submit applications and claims, to file and abandon oppositions, to submit descriptions, protests, statements, appeals and claims, to pay taxes, produce evidence of workings, to request official transcripts, to receive documents, to waive, to collect any amounts of money, to accept and register assignments, changes of name, to file and take part in mediation proceedings and/or lawsuits against any person whatsoever, in any jurisdiction in the country, for undue opposition, discontinuance of use of mark or other grounds, in which the Grantor may be a lawful party as plaintiff or defendant, filing the relevant protests and requesting nullity, with authority to submit briefs, deeds, title deeds, to prosecute, to make requests and to do any and all things necessary before the Mediators, Justices, Courts and any other judicial, federal or any other authorities; to request the appointment of experts; to question witnesses and to answer interrogatories; to attend oral proceedings, to attend pretrial conferences and other hearings; to challenge, to object, to appeal, to waive this or any other rights, to abide by judgments, to accept plaintiff's claim, to compromise and to settle; to enter applications to quash and abate rulings, proceedings and actions, to allege perjury; to submit the case to arbitrators or umpires; to demand and place bail bonds; to request preventive or definitive attachments and the release thereof; to request the sale of their debtors' assets, to file for the bankruptcy of third parties; to request and obtain the enforcement of judgments; to make and to demand oaths or promissory oaths; to collect, to issue formal receipts and acquiescences, and, in general, to perform any other acts, carry out any proceedings and take any action that may be required for the better and broadest performance hereof before any administrative or judicial authority, with authority to substitute this power of attorney totally or partially.
